Summer Recreation Program

The Summer Recreation Program is scheduled to **begin on July 1** and will **conclude on July 26, 2019**. The hours are from **8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m**. Participation in the program is limited to children who are enrolled in our pre-kindergarten program and children who are enrolled in grades K to 7 for the school year 2019-2020.

In order to take full advantage of our summer program, a child's schedule will include both recreation and academic classes, therefore, a child registering for our summer program will be following a schedule that includes recreational activities such as games, contests, field trips and many other activities. The academic classes will include English Language Arts, Mathematics, Computers, STEAM, Arts and Crafts, Physical Education and Recreation sessions. Each session will last for 50 minutes. Schedules will be distributed on Monday July 1st and will be followed each day of our summer program. Students will also have a 30 minute lunch period daily. Lunches should be packed and sent to school with your child. Lunches from local restaurants will not be delivered for the summer program due to limited time.

In order to develop the schedules for our summer program and hire the necessary faculty, anyone interested in registering their child(ren) **must complete the attached registration form by May 24th**.

The registration fee is \$400.00 for the first child and \$350.00 for each additional sibling. The fee for the program will include a minimum of two field trips. <u>PAYMENT IS TO BE MADE BY CHECK</u> <u>OR MONEY ORDER ONLY.</u> Checks and money orders are to be made out to the *South Hackensack Board of Education*.

<u>Students are expected to report to the program by 8:30 a.m.</u> Please, for the safety of your child, no child is to arrive earlier than 8:30 a.m. All parents are responsible for transporting students to and from the program each day; students will be dropped off and picked up in the "Great Hall'' (Exit F) at the back of the school, near the parking lot.
