MAXIMUM TRAVEL & EXPENSE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the South Hackensack Board of Education policy #6471 and NJAC 6A:23B-1.2(b) provides that the Board of Education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for the 2017-2018 school year.

WHEREAS, the South Hackensack Board of Education appropriated \$1,500 for travel during the 2017-2018 school year and has spent \$0.00 as of April 16, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the South Hackensack Board of Education hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2018-2019 school year at the sum of \$1,500 and
