Special Meeting Minutes Monday, March 19, 2018

She informed the board that the district is eligible to receive an adjustment to the allowable tax levy for weighted increases to enrollment and the net increase to State Aid in the amount of \$36, 613.00. The board was given two scenarios and how each scenario would impact taxes. The board reviewed the budget package provided to them and had an opportunity to ask questions. Mrs. Messery and Mr. Maceri also discussed QSAC and how it will impact the district with all the new implementations.
