

SOUTH HACKENSACK BOARD OF EDUCATION
Work Session Meeting Minutes
Monday, October 2, 2017

A work session meeting of the Board of Education was held on Monday, October 2, 2017 in the Media Center of Memorial School, 1 Dyer Avenue, South Hackensack, New Jersey. This meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by the Superintendent, Mr. Maceri

Mr. Maceri read the following statement:

The New Jersey Open Public Meetings Law was enacted to insure the right of the public to have advance notice of and to attend the meetings of the public bodies at which any business affecting their interests is discussed or acted upon. In accordance with the provisions of the Act, the South Hackensack Board of Education has caused notice of meetings published in The Record by having the date, time and place thereof posted. Notice was also placed on the Bulletin Board in the Municipal Building and in the Lobby of Memorial School.

Discussion Items:

Mr. Maceri opened his discussion by reading the Resolution from the School Ethics Commission regarding the suspension and possible removal of board member Maria Regan. He informed the board that this Resolution would be posted in the Bulletin Board in the Municipal Building and in the lobby of Memorial school for 30 days as requested by the School Ethics Commission. Mr. Maceri asked the board if there were any questions regarding this matter. No questions or comments were voiced. Ms. Schaefer reinforced to the board that the mandated training be done in a timely manner. Mr. Maceri then continued with the meeting by making a presentation to the board and parents regarding the Standardized Testing results for the district. He informed them that these results would be posted on the school's website. Parents had an opportunity to ask questions and Mr. Maceri provided the information. He thanked the parents for attending the meeting.
