Twenty-seven students were referred to I&RS during 2015-2016 school year. Nine students were referred to the Child Study Team for further evaluation. Eight of these students were classified as eligible for Special Education, one student's case is going to be opened in September. We also gave two students Section 504 accommodations. All referred students were accommodated through the professional recommendation/suggestions provided by the members of the Intervention and Referral Services committee.
