Safety Update

- Drop off is at 8:25 am, no supervision prior to that time. Thank you South Hackensack Police Department for controlling the flow of traffic.
- Every student has a lanyard, which holds their ID and is color coded to indicate belonging here. It also is used as a lunch card.
- For safety, security and convenience a secure drop box will be located in the front of the school for any paperwork, which can be dropped off at any time.
- Lunch drop off box located right outside the Great Hall doors.
- If you have a need to come into the school, please call ahead to make an appointment. We strongly discourage walk ins.
- If you are picking up a child prior to the end of the school day, your child will be escorted to you.



ATTENDANCE AWARENESS

We aim to prioritize regular student attendance students by:

- 1. Setting clear expectations for students and parents
 - Students are to be in homeroom no later than 8:30
 - Excused absences must meet specific criteria

2. Tracking data and implementing <u>tiered interventions for unexcused</u> <u>absences and tardies</u>

3. Providing attendance incentives



Excused and Unexcused Tardies in Memorial School

Excused Tardies include:

- Disability from illness or injury
- Family emergency
- Observance of religious holiday
- Religious instruction
- Medical/dental appointments that could not be otherwise scheduled
- Pupil's attendance in court
- Private lessons in music, art, dance, or private practice for competitive events
- Interview with prospective employer

Tiered Interventions for <u>Unexcused</u> tardies include

- 5 = letter mailed home to parent, detention
- 10 = letter mailed home, 2 detentions; equates to 1 absence
- 15 = letter mailed home, parent meeting required, student restricted for 10 days
- 20 = letter mailed home, parent meeting required, student may be denied participation in co-curricular activities



If your child is tardy, they <u>must</u> enter through the front door.



Excused and Unexcused Absences in Memorial School

Excused absences include:

- Student illness
- Student's attendance in court
- Consistent with IEP
- Family illness or death
- Visit to secondary school
- Unavailable medical or dental appointments
- Take A Child to Work Day
- Deemed excused by the Principal upon written request by the student's parent stating the reason for absence

Tiered Interventions for Unexcused absences include:

- 4 = letter mailed home with attendance education materials
- 5-9 = Intervention and Referral Services Referral and development of "Attendance Success Plan"
- 10-19 = potential truancy, meeting to assess outcomes of attendance success plan
- 20 or more = potential retention per policy 5410
