 - Full implementation of the LinkIt Assessment Program


General Fund TAX LEVY "Cap" Calculation

- The state calculates what the tax levy "cap" should be for SY22/23 based on the following information:
- Tax Levy from prior year + Enrollment Adjustments
- Increased (or multiplied) by 2%
- + Adjustment for increased health care costs
- +Banked Cap



Overall Impact on South Hackensack Households

On a residence assessed at \$468,662 (average), the impact of the school budget on property taxes is about \$101.34/year or \$8.45/month (2.92%).
